GUIDELINES FOR SITING OF POULTRY WASTE STORAGE STRUCTURES AND OR COMPOSTING FACILITIES

1. Minimum buffer zone of 50 feet from property lines, ditches, roads, etc. Avoid drainage swales.
2. Minimum buffer zones of 100 feet to drinking water supply wells utilizing an unconfined aquifer.
3. Site should be at least 300 feet from nearby homes.
4. Site must be above the water table and 100 year flood plain.
5. Site location must be in compliance with local zoning.
6. Screen site, if possible, from view of houses and highways.
7. Locate site in an area that will allow for future expansion.
8. Before clearing any woodland check with your local soil conservation district to determine if there may be jurisdictional wetlands on the site.
